## NON-CORPORATE SCHOOL FEES

### 2017-2018

Annual fees per student comprise the Tuition Fee plus the Registration Fee. Tuition Fees are inclusive of school bus transportation, text books, and the majority of after-school activities. ISA does not have a formal school uniform requirement.

Non-Corporate rates are only offered to families receiving no company sponsorship whatsoever. To be eligible for the Non-Corporate rate parents will be required to complete a Fee Agreement form and provide a letter(s) from their employer(s) confirming they do not contribute to school fees in any way.

Students starting part-way through an academic year will be liable for the full cost of the Registration Fee; a start date during the first semester will be liable for the full annual Tuition Fee; during the second semester, half the annual Tuition Fee; and in the fourth quarter, one quarter the annual Tuition Fee.

If a student is withdrawn part way through a school year, a 60-day notice period is required. Refund of Tuition Fees will be made on a pro-rata basis.

### Financial Support

The School offers a limited number of places for Financial Support for all grades, excluding Pre-School. There will not necessarily be any Financial Support places in a prospective student's year group at any particular time. Availability of places will depend upon the overall enrolment per grade.

Applications for Financial Support will not be accepted from families who are in receipt of either full or partial corporate support.

Eligibility for Financial Support is determined by the family's ability to afford the Tuition Fees as assessed by the School Finance Committee.

Financial Support must be applied for on an annual basis. The student's standing at school, together with the family's continuing need is considered by the Finance Committee in determining the renewal of support.

Families awarded Financial Support are still responsible for the full cost of the Registration Fee.

### **International Baccalaureate Scholarship**

Prospective International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma students may apply for an IB Scholarship, which may cover up to 100 of the Tuition Fees in Grade 11 and 12.

Award of this Scholarship is determined by the following criteria:

- whether the student will bring exemplary academic work to the IB Programme;
- whether the student will contribute to the positive social climate of ISA;
- the results of the student's interview with the IB Scholarship Committee.

The award of this Scholarship is not dependent upon financial need. The student must bring exemplary academic work to the IB Programme and show good citizenship in order to retain the Scholarship.

Parents of an IB Scholarship student are responsible for the full cost of the Registration Fee.
