Responsibilities: The elementary learning support teacher works as part of ISA's student services team to oversee the day-to-day support operations with the aim of raising achievement levels of students with identified learning needs in the elementary school. They will work directly with students as well as supporting teachers to improve their practice in addressing varied needs within their classrooms.

The elementary support teacher works with Admissions to give appropriate diagnostic and baseline assessments to newly enrolled elementary students. They liaise with external professionals, the elementary leadership, parents, colleagues and the student to provide targeted support including formal individual education plans (IEPs), and continue to liaise as they implement, review and update such plans in light of student progress. They will use relevant data to teaching strategies and the school's general approach to meeting diverse needs, and will suggest improvements.

The elementary learning support teacher collaborates with student support colleagues and the leadership team to work towards the aims of objectives of ISA's inclusion policy and reviewing and updating it. They also work with these groups to ensure that such aims and objectives correspond to and reinforce school goals. They promote an understanding of differentiated pedagogy with colleagues and the wider community.
