PRE-SCHOOL PROGRAMME

The Pre-School consists of two groups: Pre-School Junior (3-4 year olds) and Pre-School Senior (4-5 year olds).

*Children are placed in one of the two sections according to their birthdate. The 1st September is the date used to determine into which section of Pre-School a child is enrolled. A child born after 1st September may enter Pre-School when they turn 3. **A child will be eligible for the first year of School (equivalent to Primary 1 / Year 1 / Kindergarten) if they are five years old on or before 1st September.***

Children should be toilet trained and be able to reasonably manage the routines and conventions operated within the Pre-School programme. ISA reserves the right to change the initial placement, or request the withdrawal of a child from Pre-School, if subsequent observations and/or testing indicate the need for a change. There is a maximum number of places for each Pre-School session. If your child is unable to start immediately because we are at capacity or presently orienting a large number of new students, your child will be placed on the waiting list and you will be contacted as soon as a place becomes available. Pre-School children are not eligible to ride ISA buses.

Monday to Friday 8.15am to 3.00pm

After-School Care from 3pm to 6pm (Pre-School to Grade 5) is available at extra cost.

(Holidays are the same as the Elementary School)

Attendance:

Junior Section 3 to 5 days a week

Senior Section 4 to 5 days a week

Pre-School students are offered extra programmes in Music, PE and Library.

French or Spanish instruction is usually available to Pre-School Seniors.

The Dutch Mother Tongue programme is open to native speakers.

The French CNED programme is open to native speakers.
