ISA is looking for a suitably qualified maths teacher to join its teaching team. Teaching load will primarily be high school but capacity and flexibility to teach in middle school is valued. The successful candidate will be required to prepare learning opportunities for classes, facilitate in-context learning and support cross discipline projects. Inquiry-based instruction will need to be differentiated to meet student needs across the learning continuum. The teacher will also be required to develop, review and revise curriculum in the School's curriculum mapping tool (Atlas Rubicon), incorporating the school's [learning principles](#) in lessons and assessment.

The teacher will also participate in professional development and the after-school activities programme. They will establish and maintain positive relationships with other members of the school staff, showing strong collaborative skills, and communicate effectively with parents. They will attend relevant meetings and support the building of a strong sense of community at the school. Participation in parent conferences, curriculum review activities and professional development days is expected of all faculty.
