



## Required Materials for HIGH SCHOOL Classes 2019-2020

### All High School Students must have the following:

- Dark blue or black pens; pencils; coloured pens & pencils; eraser; highlighters; pencil bag
- Ruler – centimetre & inches (non-shatter), protractor
- White glue stick; hole punch; mini stapler; scissors
- A4 paper (lined with margin)
- Binder (hard cover) & dividers for each subject
- Graph paper
- Homework Diary (issued by ISA)
- Graphing Calculator TI-84 Plus C Silver Edition (although other graphing calculators *can be used, the Math Department can only offer support and additional resources for the TI-84 Plus.*)

(Please note that paper and binders in the UK are not compatible with those purchased in other countries. We recommend purchasing these in the UK.)

- A4 binder

#### SOCIAL STUDIES

- 1 Packet of 10-part dividers

#### ECONOMICS

- 1 Packet of 8-part dividers

#### HEALTH

- A4 Lined Exercise Book (Minimum 64 pages)
- A4 Display folder for storing hand-outs

#### IB MUSIC

- Large Black Folder
- Variety of solos (with accompaniment) from various genres
- IB I & II Harvard Concise Dictionary of Music
- 1 large 2" ring binder with at least 10 dividers

#### ART – HS Art & Design

- Set of drawing pencils 2B – 8B & erasers

#### ART – IB

- Your own digital camera is recommended
- Set of drawing pencils 2B – 8B and erasers
- A4 binder with clear plastic sleeves
- A2 portfolio with handle

**PHYSICAL EDUCATION (uniform requirements)**

Students must bring ALL the listed items to EVERY PE class. These items must be carried in a bag that can be zipped/buttoned/velcroed shut. Plastic shopping bags are not acceptable.

- Indoor shoes – sneakers/tennis/trainers (with non-marking soles)
- Outdoor shoes – cleats/soccer shoes are optional
- Sports/Athletic shirt/shorts, trousers or sweatpants (cut-off jeans are not acceptable)

- Water bottle
