Absenteeism and Excuse Notes:

Grade Level: ALL STUDENTS

- (a) A student who does not participate in a minimum of 66% of the scheduled classes each quarter will not receive credit for this class.
- (b) A written excuse from a parent/guardian must accompany any student that wishes to be excused from class participation. Failure to comply with this rule will result in no credit being awarded that day.
- (c) Students are encouraged to shower after every P.E. class. Please note that spray deodorants may not be used at any time in the changing room.
- (d) Mobile phones may not be used in the changing room.

Class Requirements and Units of Instruction:

- (a) Each student is expected to put forth their best effort each class
- (b) Each student will be exposed to both team and individual sports
- (c) Each student will respect all members of their class
- (d) Each student is encouraged to try new and challenging activities

Uniform Requirement:

Grade Level: ALL STUDENTS

Students must bring ALL of the listed items to EVERY class. These items must be carried in a bag that can be zipped/buttoned/velcroed shut. Plastic shopping bags are not acceptable. Belongings are not allowed to remain in the changing rooms after class. They should be carried away with the student daily.

- (a) Indoor shoes – Sneakers/tennis/trainers with non-marking soles
- (b) Outdoor shoes – Cleats/Soccer shoes are optional
- (c) Sports/Athletic socks
- (d) Sports/Athletic shorts
- (e) Water bottle

Health:

Grade Level: 9

Students will receive .5 credit for successful participation in Health class. This class will provide students with the tools to make educated choices regarding their personal health and safety for the future. There will be class discussions, short research projects and prompting for family discussion or participation on related topics.

After School Activities:

Grade Level: ALL LEVELS

Students participating in after school sports/activities must be picked up promptly when the activity is scheduled to finish. It is not acceptable for unsupervised students to remain at the gym or arrive early to watch activities they are not participating in, including those of siblings.
