GRADES 3-5

For IT classes and for use with school-issued Chromebooks, all students in Grades 3-5 will need their own pair of cheap [In-Ear Headphones](#) (also known as Wired Earbuds or Earphones). These will be kept in school for use during the school day. They do **not** need to be high quality in terms of sound production. They need to be compatible with 3.5mm headphone jacks, as found on the iPads and Chromebooks here at ISA. We also ask that these headphones are tagged/labelled and kept in a labelled bag/container. *Please note that Bluetooth headphones (including, but not limited to, brands such as Beats and AirPods) are **NOT** acceptable for this purpose.*

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

Grades K-1 are only required to change their shoes, but they should come to school on PE days dressed in suitable clothing to ensure freedom of movement. We will ask you to provide a pair of plimsolls or trainers for their use, which will be kept with their class teacher.

Grades 2-5 change their clothes for PE class. The following list is ideal for all activities:

Please make sure for ALL GRADES that items are clearly labelled with your child's name.

In the interest of student safety, all items of jewellery **MUST** be removed before class. **If your child has pierced ears then stud earrings should be worn. Staff cannot be held responsible for removing earrings but micro tape will be provided to cover them.** A valuables container will be available at the start of the lesson, and students should ensure that they collect belongings at the end of class.
